Xavier University of Louisiana prepares students in all academic areas for success. Xavier students leave our university prepared to make significant impact on a local, national and global scale.

- Ranks #1 in the nation in the number of African American graduates who graduate from medical school.
- Students who major in **Education**, complete a yearlong residency model, where students will have approximately 500 hours working with a master teacher, co-planning and co-teaching lessons.
- The **Business** division offers programs in **Accounting, Finance, Management, and Sales and Marketing**. In addition, the division houses the Entrepreneurship Institute, a resource for all students who want to start their own business and we have a strong Business Advisory Council (BAC). Many of our students receive internships and permanent job placement offers through networking with BAC members.
- Students from the division of **Fine Arts and Humanities**, the departments of **Theology, History, English, Languages, Art, Music, and Philosophy** are provided with research and internship opportunities, study abroad, and service learning activities. Graduates from this division are prepared to tackle a multitude of challenges and pave new roads to future success.
- Students in the division of **Social and Behavioral Sciences** learn and apply the skills they need to excel in the workplace or in graduate school.
- More than 45% of Xavier graduates go on to graduate or professional schools.
- 100% of **Sociology** majors complete an internship or individual research project before graduation.
